

Columbarium Interment License

This Interment License ("license"), granted and agreed to this _____ day of _____, 20_____ by and between Grace Episcopal Church of Kirkwood, St. Louis County, Missouri, a religions corporation and a parish of the Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Missouri, the Licensor hereunder, and _____ of _____, the Licensee hereunder.

Witnesseth:

1. The Licensor agrees to accept for interment in its Columbarium in the Church Building the remains refined by fire of the Licensee or the person on whose behalf Licensee has entered into this License. Such cremains shall be placed in a sealed watertight urn provided by Licensee. It shall be the responsibility of the Licensor to place such urn containing the cremains in the Columbarium. Any obligation or responsibility imposed on Licensee hereunder may be performed by Licensee's personal representative.
2. Columbarium space No. _____ in the Church Columbarium is hereby set aside for the cremains of _____. Licensor will have engraved on the granite face plate of such Vault the name and years of birth and death of such person at the Licensee's expense as follows:

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3. The Licensor shall have full and complete control over said cremains once they have been entombed in the Columbarium.
4. The Licensor shall permit the Licensee and all friends and members of the family of the deceased, and all other properly presenting themselves, to visit said Columbarium at will. If the building area in which the Columbarium is locked, it shall be opened upon request at all reasonable times.
5. It is the intention of the Licensor to maintain the Columbarium in good repair in perpetuity. However, in the event said Columbarium shall be destroyed by fire, cyclone, earthquake or other Act of God and not rebuilt, or in the event it shall be torn down or otherwise dealt with so that it no longer constitutes a portion of a church property of the Episcopal Church, then the Licensor at its sole discretion may cease to operate its said Columbarium as such. In that event the Licensor will cause said cremains, if they exist, along with all the other existing cremains entombed therewith to be removed and suitably reburied or re-entombed at some lawful cemetery or burial place in the City or County of St. Louis, Missouri, of the Licensor's own choosing, at the expense of Licensee. Licensee hereby agrees to hold Licensor harmless against any damage or expense as a result of the occurrence of any Act of God described herein.
6. In consideration of the grant of this License, the Licensee agrees to cause the Licensor to be notified of the death of the person whose cremains are to be entombed in the Columbarium. The Licensee agrees to furnish the Licensor, or cause it to be furnished, before the interment of said cremains, a copy of the cremation certificate issued by the undertaker or crematory.

7. In the event the Licensee elects not to use the Columbarium as a repository for cremains, a separate granite face plate may be inscribed as a memorial.
8. In consideration of the reservation of said Columbarium Space No. _____ and the conduct of the interment or service under this License by a member of the Episcopal Clergy, the Licensee agrees to pay the Licensor:
 - i. Registration fee: TBD payable upon execution of this License.
 - ii. Vault fee: TBD payable upon interment of the cremains.
9. The Licensee shall bear all direct costs incidental to cremation and funeral director expenses.
10. There shall be no interment or memorial service on the Church premises without its being conducted by a member of the clergy of the Episcopal Church.
11. This License is not transferable and is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Grace Church Columbarium Policies and Procedures adopted by the Vestry and which may be amended from time to time. Licensee hereby acknowledges receipt of the policies and procedures in effect this date. After the cremains have been entombed, said cremains may only be removed as set forth in the Grace Church Columbarium Policies and Procedures without refund of any amount paid by or for said Licensee and at the cost of said applicant, who shall likewise pay the cost of removing the inscription.
12. Numbering and identification of the vaults with the Columbarium shall be determined by Licensor in accordance with Appendix A attached hereto.
13. All parties understand this license agreement is subject to change.
